

Reliance Industries Stock Outlook March 2026

As of **9 March 2026**, Reliance Industries Ltd (RIL) is trading near **₹1,418.60 on the NSE**, showing a somewhat unstable start to the month. The stock has experienced noticeable **intraday volatility**, fluctuating between **₹1,370 and ₹1,429.40** during recent trading sessions.

Market estimates suggest the IPO valuation could range between **\$1 billion and \$4.5 billion**, depending on market conditions and investor demand.

If executed successfully, the listing could unlock significant value for shareholders and bring global attention to Reliance's digital ecosystem.
